**Min 1/09/2019: Preamble**

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 8.39 pm. The meeting started with a word of prayer by Eng. Sammy Muita.

**Min 2/09/2019: Confirmation of previous minutes**

The members went through the minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2018 at the Sarova Panafric Hotel, Nairobi. The minutes were proposed by John Kariuki and seconded by Joseph Limo as being a true record of what transpired during the AGM held on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2018.

### **Min 3/09/2019: Matters arising**

The Assistant Secretary Bonbegi Gesicho informed the meeting that the constitutional amendments that were passed at the previous AGM had not been formally registered with the Registrar of Societies due to the fact that the club's annual returns had not been updated since the year 1990. He requested members and former officials to assist with information about past officials so that the annual returns can be properly updated.

### **Min 4/09/2019: Patron's Report**

Mr. William Mwangi, the Chief Principal Alliance High School and the Patron of the AHS OBC presented his 2018 report and also touched on various issues that arose in the year 2019.

In his report, the Principal conveyed his gratitude towards all the efforts made by Old Boys in supporting the School. He informed the meeting that the form four class of 2018 performed very well in their KCSE exams and that 11.4% of all the plain As in the country were from the School. He also informed members that he was very confident about the class of 2019 and that he expected them to perform better than the 2018 class.

The Patron further informed members about the elaborate efforts that the School had undertaken towards engaging and benefitting its neighbouring communities. The meeting was informed that in 2018, during the week preceding Founders' Day, the boys identified a neighbouring public primary school called Thogoto Model Primary School, which they adopted. The boys skipped their lunch on one occasion; and the funds were used in purchasing sanitary towels, books and food stuffs that were donated to the primary school. Old Boy Engineer Njoroge also donated KES 100,000 to the said primary school. The Principal called for support from members on that particular initiative.

The Principal pointed out the issue of fake and misleading news about the School that had been spreading on social media. He urged members to be very keen and interrogate any news that they get about the School to avoid being misled by fake news.

In conclusion, he urged members to continue supporting the School to surmount the challenges that it faces and assured the Old Boys of his continued cooperation in all their projects.

### **Min 5/09/2019: Chairman's report**

Chairman Maurice Nduranu directed members to the published 2018 Annual Report that had been circulated among members through social media channels. In the published report the Chair recognized the crucial role of Class Marshals in mobilizing Old Boys for various Club activities and generally unifying members in their respective classes.

The Chair further acknowledged Old Boy Eng. **Sammy Muita** for his six-year role in leading the Golf Tournament that had successfully raised about KES 15 Million for the Club. He also acknowledged Old Boy **Kenneth Muchina** for his lead role in successfully organizing the Alliance Classic Run for two years running, that is 2018 and 2019. The Chair also

acknowledged the fact that there are many other old boys who have taken one cause or another and invested in ventures that bring old boys together and support the various objectives of the Club.

The Chair informed members that the club had turned sixty years old and challenged members to think about undertaking a major revolutionary activity that will mark the AHS OBC at Sixty.

The Chair invited members to give their ideas on how the Club objectives can be met. Seven members presented their ideas.

- **Joseph Maina** – 5588 asked for more Mbuji meet-ups so as to enhance networking among members.
- **Anthony Matheri** – 4606 class of 1988 asked for the devolution of the OBC and offered to host members in his hometown – Nakuru.
- **Eric Ng'eno**- 5919 class of 94 asked for the curation and maintenance of school traditions (software) which are a key unifying factor among old boys.
- **Samson Ng'eno** 6995 proposed that the club should work on improving networking opportunities for old boys.
- **Acrossian Mumbi Muthangari** proposed that the Club should take centre stage in tackling national issues through organizing national debates.
- **Old Boy Duncan Mindo** – 1585 Class of 1963 proposed that the club should have devolved chapters and he proceeded to invite members to his Nyeri home on the 26<sup>th</sup> December 2019 for a celebration marking his 50<sup>th</sup> year since being admitted as an Advocate of the High Court of Kenya and also the launching of his book.

In conclusion, the chair extended his gratitude to all the old boys who have continued to relentlessly support the Club and the School.

#### **Min 6/09/2019: AHS Endowment Fund Trust Report**

This was presented by Martin Mbaya (Class of '95) via a PowerPoint presentation. He informed members that there are two separate Endowment Funds the USA Fund and the Kenyan Fund. He informed members that thus far the Kenyan Fund was holding over KES 10 Million under investment with Fusion Investments and I&M Bank.

He urged members to continue supporting the Trust's fundraising activities such as the Alliance Classic Run and the Joint Gala Dinner.

#### **Min 7/09/2019: Consideration of the Financial Statements and Auditors Report for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018**

Kenneth Muchina, the Treasurer presented the Audited Accounts for the year 2018. The Audited Accounts were prepared by EKV Associates who were represented in the meeting by Micah Odhiambo.

The Treasurer reported that the main source of income for the club was the annual Golf Tournament that was supported by a number of corporates and individuals. He urged members to make sure that they fully support the annual Golf Tournaments so that more funds can be raised for the Club. He also encouraged members to pay for either their annual subscription fee of KES 1,000 or Life membership of KES 15,000. The accounts were proposed for adoption by Engineer Sammy Muita and seconded by Tom Imbo.

**Min 8/09/2019: Elections of members of the AHS OBC Executive Committee for the term commencing in September 2019 and ending in September 2021.**
